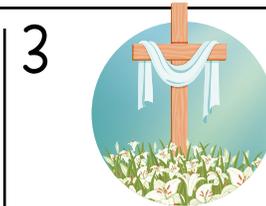

16 Trees communicate with each other underground using fungal networks, sometimes called the 'wood-wide web'.



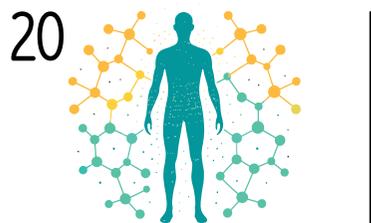
